Specific standards are required of our suppliers and ourselves, but no post-production testing is undertaken. For ARPRO Recycled grades, compliance is provided herein only for the virgin material portion (i.e. 70% in the case of ARPRO grades containing 30% post-consumer recycled (PCR) content). Although the PCR material is sourced from controlled recycling streams predominantly consisting of EPP parts, and no substances of concern are intentionally added during the recycling process, it may contain residual impurities.
